Vote:

Elections will take place via Google Form from September 19, 2023, at 4:00 PM through September 20, 2023, midnight. Election results will be posted on the TMS website by Friday, September 22, 2023.



Attend Monthly Meetings:



The principal will send out meeting information at least three days in advance. All meetings will include a time for public comment, and we encourage all parents to attend. Meetings for the 23-24 year will be held virtually through Google Meet. The link will be provided on the TMS website.

What is the role of the School Organizational Team?

- Provide input on the school performance plan and budget.
- Provide continued advice to the principal in carrying out the school plan.
- Assist with the selection of the next principal when there is a vacancy.

What are the requirements of Team members?

- Begin attending meetings in October, 2023.
- Serve on the team through September 2024, unless your child no longer attends the school.
- Attend meetings at least once per month, outside of school hours.
- Make decisions with the whole school population in mind.
- Work collaboratively and attempt to reach consensus with the team.
